

Students who complete the A.D. in Veterinary Technology and/or the B.S. in Biology with a Veterinary Technology concentration are eligible to sit for the Veterinary Technician National Examination (VTNE). Upon passing the VTNE and registration with the State Board of Veterinary Medicine, the graduate will be credentialed as a Registered Veterinary Technician (RVT). The pass rates for those who have taken the test are as follows:

Number of eligible first-time candidates	63
Number of first-time candidates that have taken the VTNE*	24
Three-year VTNE pass percentage	58.33%

*Note that graduates may choose not to attempt the VTNE when first eligible; these numbers reflect test takers who may have graduated up to five years before testing.
